**Subject: Inviting nominations for e-Governance Champions Programme (eGCP) under NeGP
Chief Information Officer's Training programme**

As part of its Capacity Building efforts for accelerating the implementation of the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP), the Department of Electronic and Information Technology (DeitY) has taken up number of initiatives for conducting specialized training programmes for the officers of Central and State Governments. The Chief Information Officers' (CIOs') Training Programme is one such comprehensive programme designed to build the knowledge and skills of selected officers who are leading or have been identified to lead **e-Governance Mission Mode Projects (MMPs)** under NeGP and other e-Governance projects in the Central Ministries/Departments or States/UTs.

2. National e-Governance Division (NeGD) under the DeitY has formulated a nation-wide rollout of the CIOs' Training Programme under the following three categories: e-Governance Leadership Programme (eGLP), e-Governance Champions Programme (eGCP) and e-Governance Executive Programme (eGEP). As a part of the national roll-out eight training batches were approved, of which six have been successfully conducted so far. The National Institute for Smart Government (NISG) is the executing agency for organizing these programmes.

3. It is now proposed to conduct the next batch in the category of e-Governance Champions Programme (eGCP) from **25th November to 21st December 2013**, for officers who are involved in the e-Governance projects of the following Ministries /Departments: **MoPR, MoUD, MoRD, Employment Exchange and e-Courts**. The eGCP is a four week programme for officers of the Central and State Government Departments involved in the respective mission mode projects. The training is scheduled to be held at Hyderabad and includes a one week domestic field study followed by one week of International training for study of international best practices. The training programme is funded by DeitY. *A brochure containing details of this programme is enclosed.*

4. The proposed eGCP will comprise a batch of 25 participants. It is requested that your Ministry/ department may take the lead for obtaining **ten (10)** nominations of officers both from the Centre and from the State/UTs. The officers should be at the level of Director, Additional Director, Joint Director or equivalent from the States with about 8-10 years' experience and officers from the Central Government department at an equivalent level. It is also requested that the officers nominated may be listed in order of priority. It is requested that the nominations may kindly be sent by **31st October, 2013**.
