The objective of this program is to foster & support the industrial collaborative R&D projects that brings together companies, research organisations & academia from India and Canada for joint co-development of Innovative products, processes or services. The aim is to deliver benefits to all participants, and more importantly, to both nations.

On behalf of the Department of Science & Technology (DST) and Department of Electronics & Information Technology (Deity), Government of India, the Global Innovation & Technology Alliance (GITA) will provide funding and other services to Indian project partners and the Canadian International Innovation Program (CIIP), which is co-delivered by Global Affairs Canada (GAC) Trade Commissioner Service and the National Research Council of Canada – Industrial Research Assistance Program (NRC-IRAP), to the Canadian project partners.

Funding support under this Program is in form of Grant to Indian Industry and partnering R&D organization/Academic institution for collaborative industrial R&D projects in the followings focus areas:

- Affordable Healthcare
- Clean Technologies (including Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency etc)
- Water Technologies (including Drinking Water, Water Purification, Water Desalination, Irrigation Technologies, Waste Water Treatment & Management)
- Information & Communication Technology (ICT)
- Electronic System Design & Manufacturing (ESDM), technologies focusing on
  - Internet of Things
  - Large Area Flexible Electronics
  - Devices for Internal Security

The Request for Proposal (RFP) under this Program has been announced on 23 March 2016 with last date of application submission is 31 August 2016.
