The McKinsey team presented the focus areas of the report on Trillion Dollar Digital Opportunity and the 30 digital themes that would pave the way. List of participants is enclosed.

The following major points emerge from the discussions:

- Competitive tax policy is required for Electronics Manufacturing in India.

- Digital Land records and GeM ecosystem are big opportunities.
- End- to-end Digital Supply Chain and flow based SME lending.
