Also, please confirm if the scope of work involves conducting field studies of the parameters enlisted in the scope of work. | No As the consortium itself is not a legal entity as per the Companies Act, 1956, they are not allowed to participate in the contract. As indicated in the contract the scope of work involve study of parameters enlisted in the scope of work. |
