I. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1) Electronics Manufacturing

- i) The following three Schemes along with their guidelines were launched by Hon'ble Minister (E&IT) during a press conference on 02.06.2020.
 - a) Modified Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC 2.0) Scheme
 - b) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for Large Scale Electronics Manufacturing
 - c) Scheme for Promotion of manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

2) UIDAI

UIDAI has released update of mAadhaar App on 17th June 2020 (for Android users) and on 20th June 2020 (for iOS users). As the latest Aadhaar service delivery mode, mAadhaar provides round the clock Aadhaar services to the resident at their finger tip.

3) National Informatics Centre

<u>Aarogya Setu – Aarogya Setu is now a popularly installed app for detecting & alerting risk perception in respect of Covid-19 of the Government of India, to aid the COVID-19 efforts of the Government.</u>

The App works based on contact tracing method and helps the Government in identifying, monitoring and mitigating the spread of COVID-19 across the country. Following the constantly rising numbers in the incidence of Covid-19 and the commencement of Unlock 1.0 during this month, the government advised passengers to download the Aarogya Setu App on their mobile phone, before commencing Rail/Air journeys. The 'Safe' indication in the app was made mandatory for allowing any passenger to undertake a journey. Further, the features of the app have always been in a dynamic mode of subtle modifications and fine tuning for public interest. Social media and television media were used extensively in the month for communicating the essentials of this app to the public and clarify all possible doubts.

Important developments under MeitY's Schemes:

- As on 30th June, 2020, total number of Aadhaar generated are 125.85 crore against the 'projected population 2020' of 137.14 crore. Aadhaar saturation (Projected Population 2020) across India stands at 88.6%.
- Total number of e-Services registered in eTaal till 30th June, 2020 is 3,878.
