**Major achievements Month of November, 2020**

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of November, 2020 are as given below:

**I. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

**1. International Cooperation**

**i) India-EU ICT JWG Follow-up - virtual meeting**

A meeting of India-EU Joint Working Group (JWG) on ICT was held on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2020, through video conferencing, under the Co-chairmanship of Mr. Rajiv Kumar, Joint Secretary, MeitY and Director Gerard de Graaf from DG-Connect, EU. Discussions were held on data and platforms, artificial intelligence and 5G (security and standardization).

**ii) 1<sup>st</sup> India-Chile virtual meeting on collaboration in ICT**

1<sup>st</sup> India-Chile virtual meeting on collaboration in ICT was held on 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 with the Ministry of Science, Technology, Knowledge & Innovation and the Production Development Corporation (CORFO) of Chile. During the meeting, discussions were held on :

- a)IT/ITES/ Software Industry/IT Parks
- b)New and Emerging Technologies like AI/ Blockchain/ML,
- c)Formal and non-formal skill development in IT/ Electronics and
- d)Innovation and Startups in Tech (IT) sector.

**2. National e-Governance (NeGD)**

An Online stakeholder conference was organized on 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Communications, Electronics & IT and Law & Justice to mark the occasion of 3 years of UMANG. International version of UMANG app and e-Book of UMANG was also launched during the conference.

**3. Digital Payments**

A promotional campaign to create awareness about BHIM-UPI over the festive period of Diwali and Bhai Dooj was executed on social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and Instagram. The campaign was centred on raising awareness of BHIM-UPI as a convenient and safe mode of payment, a platform which has seen gradual increase in usage over the past year. BHIM-UPI has recorded over 2.2 billion transactions during November 2020.

**4. UIDAI**

UIDAI has been organizing a number of workshops regarding "Aadhaar Authentication and Offline Verification" explaining Online Authentication, Aadhaar Offline Verification, Aadhaar Paperless Offline e-KYC and Secure QR code and also give live demo of applications and services. During November 2020, a workshop was conducted over Video Conference (VC) for State Government of Odisha and around 40 officers attended the workshops.

## 5. National Informatics Centre

**Aarogya Setu** – Aarogya Setu is a mobile application launched to aid the COVID-19 efforts of the Government. The App works based on contact tracing method and helps the Government in identifying, monitoring and mitigating the spread of COVID-19 across the country. More than 16.4 crore users have downloaded Aarogya Setu App till 30.11.2020.

### I. Important developments under MeitY's Schemes:

- As on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 total number of Aadhaar generated (Live) are 127.10 crore against the 'projected population 2020' of 137.05 crore. The overall Aadhaar (Live) saturation (Projected Population 2020) across India stands at 89.59%.
- Total number of e-Services registered in eTaal till November, 2020 is 3,906.

The Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) generated till November, 2020 are 422.12 lakh and DLCs generated in the month of November, 2020 are 64,02,072.

#### MyGov

MyGov has 856 discussion themes and 993 tasks. Around 1.45 crore people have registered on the Platform.

#### Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India

Around 4.50 lakh resources have been contributed under 9,198 catalogs and 2,173 Visualizations and 65,501 APIs have been created.
