Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology Major achievements for the month of April, 2023

The significant achievements pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of April, 2023 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

An addendum to SPECS scheme notification was issued on 05.04.2023 extending timelines for receipt of application for a period of 1 year i.e., up to March, 2024 and scheme duration by one year i.e., upto March 2029.

(ii) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters 2.0(EMC 2.0) Scheme

An addendum to EMC 2.0 scheme notification was issued on 06.04.2023 extending timelines for receipt of application for a period of 1 year i.e., upto March, 2024.

M/s State Infrastructure and Industrial Development Corporation of Uttarakhand (SIIDCUL), a state Industrial agency of Govt. of Uttarakhand accorded approval for establishment of EMC project over an area of 133.82 acres at Integrated Industrial Estate Kashipur, Udham Singh Nagar District, Uttarakhand with project cost of Rs. 136.35 crore including Central Financial assistance of Rs. 57.78 crore. One unit M/s Samridhi Automations has already taken space for setting up of CCTV Camera Facility in the EMC with projected investment of Rs. 175 crore and providing employment to 5,000 people.

2.A meeting with IT Secretaries from States and Union Territories was organised by MeitY on 12 April 2023 on the theme 'Digital India Initiatives for Ease of Living and Ease of Doing Business'. 28 States and Union Territories participated.

3.The Ministry of Electronics & Information technology (MeitY) notified amendments to the Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 ("IT Rules, 2021") *vide* G.S.R. 275(E) on 6.4.2023 to enforce greater due diligence by intermediaries, including online gaming intermediaries and social media intermediaries, in respect of online games and spread of fake or false and misleading information relating to government business.

4. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i) **Jeevan Pramaan:** Since inception, total 7.08 Crore Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated. Approx 2.3 lakh DLCs have been generated in the month of April 2023.
- (ii) **MyGov:** Till April 2023, MyGov has 979 discussion themes and 1410 tasks. Around 3.08 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii) **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India:** Till April 2023, more than 6.02 lakh resources have been contributed under 12,984 catalogs and 2,906 Visualizations and 1, 89, 996 APIs have been created. 96.02 lakh datasets have been downloaded.
