Monthly Achievements for the month of February, 2024

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of February, 2024 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

Applications received under the Programme for Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India includes seven (7) applications for setting up semiconductor Fabs in India, three (3) applications for setting up Display Fabs in India, fourteen (14) applications for setting up compound and ATMP facilities in India.

One application has been approved under the Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) scheme. Further, The Union Cabinet in its meeting held on 29.02.2024 has approved:

- a) One application for providing fiscal support for setting up a Semiconductor Fab facility in India.
- b) Two applications for providing fiscal support for setting up an Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test (OSAT) facility in India.

Nine (9) applications have been approved under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme.

(ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- As on February, 2024, 42 applications have been approved with proposed investment of ₹ 11,690 crore and committed incentive of ₹ 1,612 crore
- Disbursement status: As on February 2024, ₹ 378.37 crore has been disbursed to (09) applicants.

(iii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

- As on 29 February, 2024, 320 applications with proposed investment of Rs 85,450 crore are under consideration. Out of these 320 applications, 316 applications with proposed investment of approximately Rs. 83,249 crore have been approved, 3 applications with proposed investment of approximately Rs. 192 crore have been recommended by the Appraisal Committee for approval, 1 application with proposed investment of Rs 2,093 crore are under appraisal.
- As on 29 February, 2024, incentives of Rs 2286.30 crore have been released to 134 applicants.

(iv) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) 2.0 Scheme:

- EMC 2.0 Scheme was notified on 01.04.2020 to provide financial assistance for setting up of both EMC projects and Common Facility Centers (CFCs) across the country. The scheme is open for receipt of applications up to March, 2024 with disbursement period up to March, 2028.
- Under the scheme, 14 applications for setting up of EMC projects measuring an area of 4,111 acres with proposed project cost of ₹ 5,551 crore including Central Financial assistance of ₹ 2,690 crore has been received.
- 6 applications with project cost of ₹ 2,323.81 crore including Central financial assistance of ₹ 1,111.37 crore have been accorded approval.
- As on February, 2024, an amount of ₹ 175.70 crore has been released towards execution of scheme & project therein.

2. Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)

As on 29th February 2024, ₹ 1,863 crore has been released to CSC-SPV for implementation of the Scheme. A total of around 7.41 crore candidates have been enrolled and 6.35 crore have been trained, out of which 4.79 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme.

3. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i). **Jeevan Pramaan:** A total of 5,22,409 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of February 2024.
- (ii). **MyGov:** Till February 2024, MyGov has 1001 discussion themes and 1,563 tasks. Around 4.53 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii). **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India:** Till February 2024, more than 6.22 lakh resources have been contributed under 13,086 catalogs and 3,121 Visualizations and 2,26,477 Datasets APIs have been created. 1,00,60,000 datasets have been downloaded.
