Monthly Achievements for the month of January, 2024

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of January, 2024 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

Applications received under the Programme for Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India includes seven (7) applications for setting up semiconductor Fabs in India, three (3) applications for setting up Display Fabs in India, thirteen (13) applications for setting up compound and ATMP facilities in India

One application has been approved under the Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) scheme.

Nine (9) applications have been approved under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme.

(ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- As on January 2024, 40 applications have been approved with proposed investment of ₹ 11,670 crore and committed incentive of ₹ 1,608 crore
- Disbursement status: As on January 2024, ₹ 378.37 crore has been disbursed to (09) applicants.

(iii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

- As on 31st January 2024, 320 applications with proposed investment of ₹85,453 crore are under consideration. Out of these 320 applications, 316 applications with proposed investment of approximately ₹83,252 crore have been approved, 3 applications with proposed investment of approximately ₹192 crore have been recommended by the Appraisal Committee for approval, 1 application with proposed investment of ₹2,093 crore are under appraisal.
- As on 31st January, 2024, incentives of ₹ 2,262.90 crore have been released to 132 applicants.

(iv) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) 2.0 Scheme:

• EMC 2.0 Scheme was notified on 01.04.2020 to provide financial assistance for setting up of both EMC projects and Common Facility Centers (CFCs) across the country. The scheme is open for receipt of applications up to March, 2024 with disbursement period up to March, 2028.

- Under the scheme, 14 applications for setting up of EMC projects measuring an area of 4,111 acres with proposed project cost of ₹ 5,551 crore including Central Financial assistance of ₹ 2,690 crore has been received.
- 6 applications with project cost of ₹ 2,323.81 crore including Central financial assistance of ₹ 1,111.37 crore have been accorded approval.
- As on January 2024, an amount of ₹ 175.70 crore has been released towards execution of scheme & project therein.

2. Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)

As on 31 January 2024, ₹ 1,863 crore has been released to CSC-SPV for implementation of the Scheme. A total of around 7.36 crore candidates have been enrolled and 6.35 crore have been trained, out of which 4.74 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme.

3. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i) **Jeevan Pramaan**: A total of 8,29,100 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of January 2024.
- (ii) **MyGov**: Till January 2024, MyGov has 997 discussion themes and 1,559 tasks. Around 4.2 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii) Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India: Till January 2024, more than 6.19 lakh resources have been contributed under 13,080 catalogs and 3,098 Visualizations and 2,23,494 Datasets APIs have been created. 1,00,27,000 datasets have been downloaded.
