Monthly Achievements for the month of November, 2023

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of November, 2023 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

A total of forty-five (45) applications have been received under the Programme for Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India. This includes six (6) applications for setting up semiconductor Fabs in India, three (3) applications for setting up Display Fabs in India, Ten (10) applications for setting up compound and ATMP facilities in India

One application has been approved under the Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) scheme.

Nine (9) applications have been approved under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme.

(ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- As on November 2023, 38 applications have been approved with proposed investment of ₹ 11,485 crore and committed incentive of ₹ 1,574 crore
- Disbursement status: As on November 2023, ₹ 365.43 crore has been disbursed to (06) applicants.

(iii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

As on 30 November, 2023, 320 applications with proposed investment of ₹ 85,571 crore are under consideration. Out of these 320 applications, 316 applications with proposed investment of approximately ₹ 83,314 crore have been approved, 2 applications with proposed investment of approximately ₹ 164 crore have been recommended by the Appraisal Committee for approval, 2 applications with proposed investment of ₹ 2,093 crore are under appraisal.

• As on 30 November, 2023, incentives of ₹ 2211.14 crore have been released to 131 applicants.

(iv) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) 2.0 Scheme:

- EMC 2.0 Scheme was notified on 01.04.2020 to provide financial assistance for setting up of both EMC projects and Common Facility Centers (CFCs) across the country. The scheme is open for receipt of applications up to March, 2024 with disbursement period up to March, 2028.
- Under the scheme, 14 applications for setting up of EMC projects measuring an area of 4,108 acres with proposed project cost of ₹ 5,708 crore including Central Financial assistance of ₹ 2,757 crore has been received.
- 5 applications with project cost of ₹ 2,219 crore including Central financial assistance of ₹ 1,036 crore have been accorded approval.
- As on November 2023, an amount of ₹ 134.17 crore has been released towards execution of scheme & project therein.

2. Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)

As on 30 November 2023, ₹ 1863 crore has been released to CSC-SPV for implementation of the Scheme. A total of around 7.23 crore candidates have been enrolled and 6.26 crore have been trained, out of which 4.67 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme.

3. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i) Jeevan Pramaan: A total of 93,85,136 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of November 2023.
- (ii) MyGov: Till November 2023, MyGov has 991 discussion themes and 1535 tasks. Around 3.6 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii) Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India: Till November 2023, more than 6.17 lakh resources have been contributed under 13,074 catalogs and 3,052 Visualizations and 2,15,808 Datasets APIs have been created. 99,30,000.93 datasets have been downloaded.
