Monthly Achievements for the month of October, 2024

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of October, 2024 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

As on October, 2024, following applications have been approved under the scheme:

- a) One application has been approved under the Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) scheme
- b) One application for providing fiscal support for setting up a Semiconductor Fab facility in India.
- c) Three applications for providing fiscal support for setting up an Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test (OSAT) facility in India

Further, Fourteen (14) applications have been approved under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme.

(ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- 19th Executive Committee meeting was held on 28.10.2024 wherein 07 cases were presented before the committee for its consideration. The EC recommended/approved 06 cases with total project cost of INR 7,283.16 crore.
- Incentive of INR 6.72 crore has been disbursed to 02 applicants in the month of October 2024.

(iii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

- As on October, 2024, 319 applications with proposed investment of Rs 83,801 crore are under consideration. Out of these 319 applications, 317 applications with proposed investment of approximately Rs. 81,768 crore have been approved, 1 applications with proposed investment of approximately Rs. 24 crore have been recommended by the Appraisal Committee for approval, 1 application with proposed investment of Rs 2,009 crore are under appraisal.
- Incentives of Rs 8.85 crore has been disbursed to 3 applicants in the month of October 2024.

(iv) Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI) for IT Hardware:

Till 31st October 2024, both PLI Scheme for IT Hardware and PLI Scheme
2.0 for IT Hardware have combinedly led to a total cumulative production of

Rs. 10245.04 crore, total cumulative investment of Rs. 501.47 crore and total cumulative employment of 4520 (direct jobs).

2. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i). **Jeevan Pramaan**: A total of 7,99,675 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of October 2024.
- (ii). **MyGov**: Till October 2024, MyGov has 1017 discussion themes and 1660 tasks. Around 4.86 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii). **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India**: Till October 2024, more than 5.04 lakh resources have been contributed under 12,736 catalogs and 3,280 Visualizations and 2,50,893 Datasets APIs have been created. 1,04,55,846 datasets have been downloaded.
