# Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology Major achievements for the month of June, 2023

The significant achievements pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of June, 2023 are as given below:

## 1. Electronics Manufacturing

- (i) Modified scheme for setting up of Compound Semiconductors / Silicon Photonics / Sensors
  Fab and Semiconductor Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) / OSAT
  facilities in India
  - Six (6) applications have been received till date and appraised under the Scheme.
  - The Cabinet in its meeting held on 14.06.2023 has approved Application of Micron Technology Inc. titled Project Pioneer for fiscal support from Government of India for setting up an ATMP facility in India.
  - The approval letter to MTI was issued by ISM on 15.06.23, and their acceptance
    was received on 20.06.23. The MTI is doing inter-company agreements to transfer
    technology and equity to the India entity after that Fiscal Support Agreement will
    be signed.
  - Five (5) applications have been approved under the DLI scheme.

## (ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- One approval letter was issued dated 27.06.2023 with proposed investment of Rs. 10 crore.
- Governing Council meeting was held on 19.06.2023 for inclusion of item and modification in SPECS guidelines for effective functioning of the scheme.

#### (iii) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC)

A sanction for release of Grant-in-aid of Rs. 7.50 crore in favor of M/s MCCIA Electronic Cluster Foundation (MECF) towards development of CFC at Pimpri Industrial Area, Pune, Maharashtra was issued on 09.06.2023.

#### (iv) EMC 2.0

An application for setting up of EMC at Mundra, Gujarat over an area of 186.45 acres with proposed project cost of Rs. 300 crore including Central financial assistance of Rs.

130.20 crore was submitted by M/s Mundra Solar Technopark Pvt. Ltd. (MSTPL) on 06.06.2023.

## (v) National Centre for Large Area Flexible Electronics (NCFlexE)

A proposal for consideration of Phase-II of the NCFlexE Centre with a project cost of Rs. 83.08 crore including Central financial assistance of Rs. 60.00 crore was received and processed for IFD concurrence. A review was also undertaken by AS, MeitY on 19.06.2023.

### 2. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i) **Jeevan Pramaan:** A total of 2.026 lakh Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of June 2023.
- (ii) **MyGov:**Till June 2023, MyGov has 983 discussion themes and 1438 tasks. Around 3.17 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii) **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India:** Till June 2023, more than 6.09 lakh resources have been contributed under 13,034 catalogs and 2,949 Visualizations and 1,93,513 APIs have been created. 96.79 lakh datasets have been downloaded.
