Inviting feedback on the draft amendments to the IT (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 in relation to online gaming:

- (a) Extension of time; and
- (b) Inclusion in the draft of amendments relating to due diligence by an intermediary.

Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology has published on its website, on 2nd January 2023, draft amendments to the IT (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 in relation to online gaming. Feedback from public was invited by 17th January 2023.

In the meantime, the Ministry has also considered amendments relating to due diligence by an intermediary under rule 3(1)(b)(v) of the said rules. Feedback is invited from the public on these draft amendments as well. Submissions will not be attributed to individuals publicly and will be held in fiduciary capacity to enable persons submitting the feedback to provide the same freely.
