To ensure equitable geographical reach, each of the 2,50,000 Gram Panchayats across the country are envisaged to register an average of 200-300 candidates.</p> <p>As on 31st March 2024, Rs. 1903.92 crore has been released to CSC-SPV for implementation of the Scheme. A total of around 7.42 crore candidates have been enrolled and 6.45 crore have been trained, out of which 4.83 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme. The PMGDISHA Scheme has been officially concluded on 31.03.2024</p>

Additionally, it targets underprivileged regions like the North Eastern Region, Backward Districts and Blocks, and Districts withover 40% SC/ST population. The program's objective is to promote comprehensive growth in the IT sector through various endeavors, including Infrastructure Creation, Training, Capacity Building, and Entrepreneurship Creation in the IECT domain.</p> <p>Since the financial year 2007-08, the IT for Masses program has extended its benefits to 5.55 lakh women, 1.03 lakh Scheduled Caste, and 0.53 lakh Scheduled Tribe candidates.</p> <p>A total of Rs.58.60 crore has been disbursed for ongoing projects under this program.</p>
