

Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology
Major achievements Month of September, 2019

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of September, 2019 are as given below:

I. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

i) Electronics Manufacturing

A round table meeting under the chairmanship of Hon'ble MEIT was organized with the key leaders of Electronics Industry at Vigyan Bhawan on 16.09.2019 wherein discussions were held with the CEOs of Electronics Industry to attract more investment in the sector for promotion of electronics manufacturing in the country.

ii) Aadhaar

UIDAI has been organizing a number of workshops regarding "Aadhaar Offline Applications and Services" explaining Aadhaar Offline Verification, Aadhaar Paperless Offline e-KYC and Secure QR Code and also gives live demonstration of applications and services. During September 2019, two workshops were conducted at Bhubaneswar and Chennai for various State Government departments of Odisha and Tamil Nadu, respectively.

A 35 member delegation from Maldives visited UIDAI Headquarters on 25th September, 2019. A presentation on Aadhaar was given to the visiting delegation.

iii) International Cooperation

The Indian side, led by Minister of State (Commerce & Industry), participated in 84th Thessaloniki International Fair (Greece) held during 7-15 September, 2019 and MeitY's pavilion showcased the subject "New India-Digital India".

iv) Digital Payments

Data Security Council of India (DSCI) in collaboration with MeitY and Google launched a nationwide campaign called 'Digital Payment Abhiyan' to educate users about the benefits of digital payments and to adopt best practices for safe & secure transactions.

v) Under the Digital India initiatives, MeitY alongwith NASSCOM and State Government is setting up Centres of Excellence on Internet of Things (CoE-IoT). Hon'ble Minister (Electronics & Information Technology) inaugurated CoE-IoT at Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Gandhinagar on September 11, 2019. The Centre will cater to the needs of ICT industry from Western India and will help the entrepreneurs to convert their ideas into marketable products. This centre will primarily focus on Industry 4.0 and Healthcare.

Important developments under MeitY's Schemes:

- As on 30th September, 2019, total number of Aadhaar generated (Live) are 120.91 crore against the 'projected population 2019' of 135.39 crore. Aadhaar saturation (Projected Population 2019) across India stands at 89.31%.
- Total number of e-Services registered in eTaal till 30th September, 2019 is 3,744.

MyGov

MyGov has 812 discussion themes and 849 tasks. Around 94.97 lakh people have registered on the Platform and each one is receiving weekly newsletter.

Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India

Around 3.22 lakh resources have been contributed under 7,706 catalogs and 1,846 Visualizations and 16,400 APIs have been created.
