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1	1	General Information	Last date of submission of Bid is Thursday 13th November, 2014 12:00 Hrs	<p>NSEIT: We request extension of Bid submission by 2 additional weeks from the date of replies of pre-bid queries.</p> <p>APTECH: As discussed during the pre bid meeting, we request you to kindly extend the date of tender submission if the changes suggested by us are accepted by the committee, we are requesting this extension as the RFP is very exhaustive and needs time to prepare, hence please extend the date of submission for at least two week from the last date of submission.</p>	Agreed, the date of submission of Bid is extended by three weeks from date of publishing of clarification on pre-bid queries on the website
2	18	8	The selected bidder will deploy technically qualified, experienced, adequate manpower to manage the entire examination process at each exam centre as per SOP of the examination. There should be at-least one technical person directly from the Bidder Organisation managing LAN (server) and one person as Center In-charge/ Examination Superintendent at the Examination centre.	<p>NSEIT: NSEIT will have a SPOC at every Test center managing the Test Software Servers. The IT Support at Test Center Venue is normally managed by the third party Venue provider.</p> <p>Sify: For how long (in weeks or months) are these resources need to be deployed? We assume full time till renewal of contract. Pls confirm.</p>	As per RFP. The Center In-charge must be competent enough to handle the examination centre but may not be directly from the bidder organisation.
3	17	5.2 point-11	Online Registrations Module: This module will be required for online registration of candidates with their statistical, biometric and authentication information.	<p>TCS: TCS would request NIELIT to provide a clarity if biometric data has to be uploaded during the online registration. Uploading biometric data during registration would pose a challenge as there is non uniformity in the biometric devices available at various locations.</p> <p>Sify: We assume that biometric information shall be captured at the time of appearing at examination center, and not at the time of registration. Please confirm.</p>	<p>As per RFP. In the absence of UIDAI Aadhaar number, Biometric details of the candidate are to be captured in only non-Aadhaar States.</p> <p>But even for non-Aadhaar States facility for Aadhaar registration will be provided at NIELIT Centres and/or CSC Centers.</p> <p>Where Aadhaar details are not available, Bio-Metric shall be captured at Exam Venue and shall be verified.</p>

TCS: TCS would request NIELIT to provide clarification on this module. Sify: What is the need of adding this module within the examination system? Also, does it imply that NIELIT's legacy payroll system/ vendor mgmt system needs to be integrated with Exam portal?	Agreed.

We suggest NIELIT that center selection should not be given to candidates as that would increase chances of malpractise by enabling a group of candidates/friends to opt for the same center.	Agreed, the candidate will be able to give preference for the city not the examination centre.

TCS: NIELIT would have an access to Command Center module and can view the status of present candidates once the log in is done. TCS would request NIELIT to provide clarification on this module. The Bio-Metric attendance of the ES, Observer and Invigilation staff will also be captured to ensure their presence and fixing responsibility, in addition to candidates taking examination.

NSEIT: Given the large volume of exams going Online. It is our request that NIELIT provide candidate data at least 4 weeks in advance in order to make Test Center venue booking.	As per RFP. This will be generally for small exam to the tune of normally 10000 candidates in selected cities, for larger exams due time shall be given.

Two months period is meant for initial preparations first time after award of contract (one month for system study and customisation as per NIELIT requirement and one month for deployment and testing before going live).	NSEIT: Given the Scope of Work, we estimate design, development & NIELIT specific customization. Hence we request at least 6-8 months for Go-Live from award of contract. Pls confirm how many and which all languages the software should support.</p>	As per RFP. It is as per candidate choice and availability of QB in that language otherwise by default English and Hindi. Hindi language will get replaced by Regional Language based on the choice given at the time of filling examination form by the candidate.
